It's time to announce our two summer solo missions!

The first summer solo mission allows your agent to participate in the 1st ever MPKids Christmas card contest! Your agent's art entry and the attached Mission Report may be returned to the attention of Jan Leach at either the church office or the narthex desk, but must be submitted by June 20, 2008 (or postmarked by June 25, 2008 if mailing directly to Mission Control). Please take a minute to review the rules with your agent. Agents will be competing with other MPKid agents from chapters all over the U.S.!! Your agent may submit more than one entry, but all agents receive one mission star for participating!

The second summer solo mission asks agents to collect even more school supplies to help support Orphan Outreach! Your agent should wear their MPKids t-shirt to school (if possible) and take the Mission ID sheet to their current and past teachers spreading the word that they are collecting leftover school supplies. Agents need to drop off all collected items and the attached Mission Report to the marked bin outside the Children's Ministry offices (upstairs in the main building) no later than July 6, 2008. The Mission Report may also be turned in to the attention of Jan Leach at the church offices or the narthex desk.
